### OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

- Card Stock
- Regular Paper
- Mini Brads
- Glue

#### STEP 1

Import the Cricut Cut File

#### STEP 2

Cut out the card stock paper. This is also the step where you may want to cut out the accent layer as well if you would like accent paper on the outside like the ivory ones on the left. Line up the holes and glue the layers together before moving on to the next step. ...or not if you are planning on decorating with stamps at the end.

#### STEP 3

Cut the regular paper. I used printer paper and would cut two pages for every matchbook. Be sure to reduce your pressure and speed since it is more delicate than the card stock.

#### STEP 4

With the holes to the left, score the long piece at 3/4", 7/8", 4" & 4 1/2" for 20 pages in the matchbook.

#### STEP 5

Insert the 20 pages and the smaller rectangle through the holes with the card stock in the back.

#### STEP 6

Glue the cardstock to the inside of the 'matchbook'.

#### STEP 7

Decorate the front with stamps as you would like.

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
