OTHER MATERIALS NEEDED

- Art Philosophy cricut cartridge CTMH
- small calendar pages
- Twilight ink
- small brads
- Paper Piercing Tool
- Clementine Paper Pack
- Dark Chocolate Striped Ribbon
- Sorbet ink
- favorite adhesive
- Big Bite

STEP 1

Using your gypsy, CCR, or DS, cut out the 2013 from the Artiste cartridge. I staggered mine up and down then welded them together to cut out a one. I used 1.18 for the height. Then I sponge it, attach it and you are done. Pretty simple don't you think? Have fun!



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STEP 2

Measure your coaster and cut a pattern paper to match. Glue pattern paper and sand edges taking off any excess paper. sponge in a complementary color.

STEP 3

print up your free downloadable calendar pages. You can find them on my blog: <http://michelesinkitstampit.blogspot.com/2012/12/getting-ready-for-new-year.html>

Cut them out and stack them in order with Jan on the top.

Using your paper Piercing Tool poke two holes one on each side at the top and place the brads in them to hold them together and so the pages can be ripped off at the end of each month. Sponge around it in the complementary color. Set it aside.

STEP 4

Using the cut out shape Art Philosophy> Square3 page 43. I cut mine at 2.88high on my gypsy. Sponge around the cut out shape. Then attach the calendar to it so they are centered and attach that to the coaster. Placing it lower so you have room for the bow on top. Punch two holes at the top about 1/2 inch apart. Use your Ribbon and tie a bow.
